Turkish Banking Sector Non-Consolidated Main Indicators (July 2011)

According to the **unconfirmed temporary data*** the banks submitted to our Agency, asset size of the Turkish Banking Sector was 1.159.380 as of July 2011. Total assets of the sector increased by TL 152.709 million (15.2%) when compared to end-2010. As of July 2011, loans and securities which are among the biggest placement items showed a balance respectively by TL 627.659 million and 279.082 million. While loans increased by 19.4% when compared to end-2010, NPL (gross) and securities decreased respectively by 5.8% and 3%. Within the last one-year period, loans increased by TL 170.472 million (37.3%), while total assets increased by TL 258.990 million (28.8%). In July 2011, profit of the sector was TL 11.961 million and profit for the period decreased by TL 1.586 million (11.7%) when compared to last year. Capital Adequacy Standard Ratio which was 19.3% in July 2010 decreased by 2.3 points and realized as 17% as of July 2011.
