**FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS RELATING TO THE DECISION ON THE PRINCIPLES AND PROCEDURES ON THE PAYMENT OF THE AMOUNTS COLLECTED UNDER THE NAME OF THE SALE OF DOMESTIC GOVERNMENT BONDS BY T. IMAR BANKASI TÜRK ANONİM ŞİRKETİ WHOSE LICENSE OF MAKING BANKING TRANSACTIONS AND ACCEPTING DEPOSIT HAS BEEN ABOLISHED**

**Question 1: My Lawsuit continues in administrative court. Should I apply to Savings Deposit Insurance Fund?**

**Answer:** Your continuing lawsuit does not constitute an obstacle for you to apply to the Savings Deposit Insurance Fund. By making your application, you can collect the amount determined in the Decision of the Council of Ministers and the interest operated according to the Decision of the Council of Ministers.

**Question 2: I have not filed a lawsuit through administrative court. Can I apply to the Savings Deposit Insurance Fund?**

**Answer:** It does not matter whether or not you filed a lawsuit in the applications to be made to the Savings Deposit Insurance Fund. **All persons entitled** can apply even if he or she has not filed a lawsuit

**Question 3: I have a lawsuit proceeding in the administrative court, yet the court gave a ruling and the law suit is at appeal level. Can I apply to the Savings Deposit Insurance Fund?**

**Answer:** That your law suit is at appeal level does not constitute an obstacle to apply to the Savings Deposit Insurance Fund. By applying, it is possible to cash the transaction amount specified in the Decision of the Council of Ministers and the interest to be operated in accordance with the Decision of the Council of Ministers.

**Question 4: I have a lawsuit proceeding in the administrative court, however the court gave a ruling and the law suit is at judgment correction level. Can I apply to the Savings Deposit Insurance Fund?**

**Answer:** That your law suit is at judgment correction appeal level does not constitute an obstacle to apply to the Savings Deposit Insurance Fund. By applying, it is possible to cash the transaction amount specified in the Decision of the Council of Ministers and the interest to be operated in accordance with the Decision of the Council of Ministers.

**Question 5: How would my law suit on trail be affected should I apply to the Savings Deposit and Insurance Fund?**

**Answer:** The payment to be made to you by the Savings Deposit and Insurance Fund will be notified by the Banking Regulation and Supervision Agency and Capital Markets Board to the court at which your law suit is judged. It is obvious that the conduct of the law suit is in the discretion of the court.

**Question 6: I have a lawsuit adjudicated in the administrative court, but the judgment delivered has not become final yet. What should I do?**

**Answer:** By applying to the Savings Deposit Insurance Fund, you can cash the transaction cost specified in the Decision of the Council of Ministers and the interest to be operated in accordance with the Decision of the Council of Ministers.

**Question 7: Does the application depend on a certain period?**

**Answer:** You should apply to the Savings Deposit Insurance Fund until the end of office hours on August 10, 2007. Payments relating to the applications to be made following this date and to applications made within the period but with incomplete documents are transferred to T.C. Ziraat Bankası A.Ş. by the Fund in order to be paid to the persons entitled in sixty days as of the date the delayed demand is reached to the Fund or the incomplete information and documents are completed and transported to the Application Acceptance Center of the Fund in Büyükdere Cad.
