Main Indicators of Turkish Banking Sector (31.07.2010)

According to **uncertain temporary data** sent by banks to our Agency's data base *, asset size of Turkish Banking Sector amounts to TL 900.390 million as of July 2010. Total assets of the sector increased by TL 139.929 million (18,4%) in the last one year period. Within asset items, loans amount to TL 457.187 million and securities amount to TL 273.983 million. Loans and securities increased by 16,4% and 4,2% respectively when compared to end-2009 while NPLs (gross) decreased by 3,7%. The profit of the sector in July 2010 amounts to TL 13.547 million and the term profit increased by TL 825 million and by 6,5% when compared to the previous year. The capital adequacy ratio of the sector which was 19,8% in July 2009 is realized as 19,3% as of July 2010.
