

Monthly Banking Sector Data Planned Revision Studies

As of March 2022, the following classification criteria will be used in the SME Loans table, due to the amendment made in the regulation on the Definition, Qualifications and Classification of Small and Medium-Sized Enterprises published in the Official Gazette dated 18.03.2022.

According to the regulation;

SME: Enterprises defined as micro, small or medium-sized enterprises that employ less than 250 employees annually and whose annual net sales revenue or financial balance do not exceed 250 million Turkish Liras.

Micro-scale enterprise: Enterprises that employ less than 10 employees annually and whose annual net sales revenue or financial balance do not exceed 5 million TL.

Small-scale enterprise: Enterprises that employ less than 50 employees annually and whose annual net sales revenue or financial balance do not exceed 50 million TL.

Medium-scale enterprise: Enterprises that employ less than 250 employees annually and whose annual net sales revenue or financial balance do not exceed 250 million TL.
