Turkey Regulator Says No U.S. Probe Into Banks, Denying Reports

There's no investigation into Turkish banks and U.S. authorities have not sent any information or documents to Turkish counterparts, the head of Turkey's banking regulator BDDK, Mehmet Ali Akben, tells Bloomberg by phone.

Akben responds to report in Haberturk newspaper that the U.S. is preparing to impose heavy fines on 6 Turkish banks for violations related to their business with Iran "The news definitely does not reflect the truth. There's no investigation into Turkish banks. We have received no information or documents from the U.S."

Akben says the news is a violation of Turkish banking laws.
